### SUBSCRIBE TO FALCON FLASH

**Don't miss out - be in the know!**

**Falcon Flash** is the school's e-newsletter published at the end of each week. Each issue contains important communications from the school, timely information about upcoming events, and other articles of interest to our community.

If you already receive Falcon Flash via email each week, no action is required on your part.

**For those of you who do not receive Falcon Flash, and would like to, action is required.**

Some families have assumed the school sets up emails addresses to receive Falcon Flash. Due to anti-spam laws, it is not permissible to enroll email addresses that you provide to the school for bulk email communications. Therefore, it is up to you to subscribe to receive Falcon Flash. There is a very easy way to do so.

On every page of our website, [cascadeheights.org](http://cascadeheights.org), there is a box in the lower left hand corner labeled "**Subscribe to Falcon Flash.**" Enter your email address and the code that proves you are not a robot and click on "Subscribe." That's it! You may unsubscribe at any time by using the unsubscribe link that is at the bottom of every issue. ### ADDITIONAL OPTION FOR MORNING CARLINE

**Take a test drive in January and let us know what you think!**

Thanks to a great idea that came out of our first Teacher Tea, we will be trying something new for morning drop-off. From January 4 to the 14, you will have two options for morning drop-off:

- If you would like to drop off your child and then drive away, please pull up in the loading/unloading zone, allow your child to safely exit on the curb/passenger side, and then exit back out into the road. Your child will enter through the front door between 7:45 am and 8:00 am, like normal.
- If you would like to sit in your car while you wait, or if you would like to walk your child down to their classroom, please park in the gravel lot. From 7:45 am to 8:00 am, the SIDE DOOR (south wing) will be opened for families or children to enter there as well.

Please be sure...

- To pull up all the way up to the tree when dropping off to allow room for cars behind you.
- That you are NOT idling or parking in the loading/unloading zone at any time during the regular school day.
